Goal of MIHP

MIHP is a home visiting program, providing care coordination and education for pregnant and infant Medicaid beneficiaries. The goal of MIHP is to support Medicaid beneficiaries in order to promote healthy pregnancies, positive birth outcomes, and infant health and development. MIHP services are intended to supplement medical (prenatal and infant) care. MIHP provides care coordination and intervention services, focusing on the mother-infant dyad. Care coordination services are provided by a registered nurse and licensed social worker, one of whom is designated as the Care Coordinator. Intervention services are provided by a registered nurse, a licensed social worker, registered dietitian (with a physician order), and an infant mental health specialist, depending on the beneficiary's particular needs.
